Revised Travel Advisory issued

The Government of India has taken following actions for prevention and management of Coronavirus COVID-19

- **All existing visas**, except diplomatic, official, UN/International Organizations, employment, project visas, **stand suspended till 15 April 2020.**
- **Visa free travel facility granted to OCI card holders is kept in abeyance till 15 April 2020.**
- This will come into effect from 1200 GMT on 13 March 2020 at the port of departure.
- **Any foreign national who intends to travel to India for compelling reason may contact the Indian Consulate.**
- All incoming travellers, including Indian national, arriving from or having visited China, Italy, Iran, Republic of Korea, France, Spain and Germany after 15 February 2020 shall be quarantined for a minimum period of 14 days.
- Incoming travellers, including Indian nationals, are advised to avoid non-essential travel and are informed that they can be quarantined for a minimum of 14 days on their arrival in India.
- Indian nationals are strongly advised to avoid all non-essential travel abroad. On their return, they can be subjected to quarantine for a minimum of 14 days.
- International traffic through land borders will be restricted to Designated check posts with robust screening facilities. These will be notified separately by Ministry of Home Affairs.
