- Around 13,000 million sq m of Man-made Fabrics and about 90% of polyester fabrics used in India is manufactured in Surat
- Nearly 30 million meters of raw fabric and 25 million meters of processed fabric are produced in the city daily
- Surat is the largest manufacturer of cloth in India with over 800 cloth wholesalers
