## Celebration of 71<sup>st</sup> Constitution Day of India

Consulate General of India, Sao Paulo and Swami Vivekananda Cultural Centre, Sao Paulo celebrated the Constitution Day of India on 26 November 2020. This year the celebrations were confined only to the officers of the Consulate and the cultural centre owing to the restrictions imposed by the local government on large gatherings due to COVID-19.

The celebration started with the reading of the Preamble of the Indian Constitution by the officials of Consulate General of India and Swami Vivekananda Cultural Centre, led by the Consul General, Mr. Amit Kumar Mishra within the premises of the Indian Consulate in Sao Paulo. The officials of Consulate General of India, later assembled at the Swami Vivekananda Cultural Centre and documentary films on the Constitution like 'The Preamble', 'The Constitution' by XP Division were screened. The copy of 'Constitution of India', was brought out of the storage and was put on display giving the officials an opportunity to browse through it at leisure and appreciate this intricately calligraphed and illustrated document.
