Resumption of Tourist Visas

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all visas granted to foreigners were suspended last year. Various other restrictions were also imposed on international travel by the Government of India to check the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 2. Given the improvement in the COVID-19 situation in India, Government of India has decided to commence issuing Tourist Visa, as per the details below:
- (i) Foreign nationals intending to visit India for tourism purposes will be allowed to enter into India on e-Tourist Visa/Tourist Visa through chartered flights (for group tourism only) from 15 October 2021.
- (ii) All individual foreign nationals intending to travel to India for tourism purposes through Vande Bharat Mission, Air Bubble or by any scheduled/non-scheduled commercial flights as slowed by the Ministry of Civil Aviation would be permitted to enter India from 15 November 2021.
- (iii) The above-mentioned foreign nationals would be required to obtain a fresh e-Tourists/Regular Tourist visa from Bureau of Immigration or Mission/Consulate.
- (iv) Existing valid e-Tourists Visa/Regular Tourist Visa continue to remain suspended. All foreign tourists will have to seek fresh tourist visas.
- (v) The new e-Tourist/Regular Tourist visas would be issued for 30 days with single entry.
- (vi) Such foreign nationals shall be permitted to enter India by sea routes or by flights but not through land Integrated Check Posts.
- (vii) The first 500,000 tourist visas would be issued on 'Gratis' basis and admissible only once per tourist.
- 3. Foreign nationals desirous to visit India for tourism purposes are encouraged to apply for e-Tourist visas at https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa/tvoa.html or regular Tourist visa at the Consulate, as per above guidelines.
