REQUIREMENTS FOR INTENDED MARRIAGE

- **1. Notice for intended** marriage (4 copies) form, duly filled-in.
- 2. Declaration by prospective bride and bridegroom (in duplicate by each).
- **3**. Sworn affidavit by prospective bride and bridegroom (in duplicate by each), duly attested by Indian Consulate.
- **4**. Four identical passport size recent photographs (by each). At least one of the parties must be on a residence visa of Brazil.
- **5**. Three witnesses (holding residence visa of Brazil) with their original valid passports and passport photocopy.
- **6**. If one of the parties is other than Indian, No Objection Certificates/Affidavit (in respect of his/her martial status and willingness to marry an Indian) from the concerned Consulate/ Embassy and attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Brazil.
- 7. All five persons are required to appear before Marriage Officer/Consular Officer for signatures with their original passport and a photocopy both at the time of submission of forms and at the time of solemnization of the Marriage. Photocopy of Passports required only at the time of submission of form.
- **8**. After submission of forms, newspaper advertisement (original cutting) is to be given by the individuals for publication in local English Newspaper as well as English Newspaper in India/concerned country in the place of permanent residence indicated in the passport. The advertisement should contain the full text provided by the Consulate.

ALL THE PARTICULARS IN THE FORMS MUST BE FILLED IN AS PER THE PASSPORT.
